All research involving the use of animals must comply with the *Animal Welfare Act 2002* (WA) and the requirements of the *Australian code for the care and use of animals for scientific purposes* (8th edition, 2013).

'The Code' (clause 2.4.34) - Investigators must provide the following to the AEC, in accordance with AEC and institutional policies and procedures:

- (i) an annual report for an approved project, regardless of the duration of AEC approval for the project.
- (iii) a final report on outcomes as soon as practicable after completion or discontinuation of a project.

- Annual Animal Use Reports <u>must</u> be submitted <u>before</u> <u>Monday 19 January 2026</u>. Late submissions will not be accepted.
