

Form LB3: Declaration and Exemption

Equines from the Northern Territory travelling to the Kimberley Region for performance competition and returning to the Northern Territory within 28 days

Biosecurity and Agriculture Management Act 2007 (BAMA) and Biosecurity and Agriculture Management Regulations 2013

This declaration provides evidence for the exemption of the described equines from the Northern Territory, entering the Kimberley Region for 28 days or less, from inspection by an authorised inspector for declared plant material and exemption of the transport vehicle from washdown on entry into Western Australia.

- Complete both Table 1 and the declaration on page 2 and 3.
- This form is to be attached to the completed species-specific Form LB1: [Health certificate for movement of stock to Western Australia](#).
- Forms LB3 and LB1 should be emailed to the relevant WA Entry Inspection Point (below) at least 3 days before arriving at the WA border checkpoint and signed copies must accompany the livestock.

being the owner/manager of the animals described in Table 1, declare that:

- The animals:
 - Are entering Western Australia in vehicle registration number _____
 - Have not been in the State of Queensland at any time in the two months immediately prior to entry
 - Have been confined to areas free of mesquite, prickly acacia, parkinsonia and mimosa for at least 14 days immediately prior to entry
 - Were groomed within 24 hours immediately prior to entry
 - Will spend no more than 28 days in Western Australia and remain only in the Kimberley Region
- There is no fodder or bedding accompanying the equines or in or on the transport vehicle
- The transport vehicle, the hooves and hair of the animals including mane and tail, and all rugs and equipment accompanying them are free of plant material. The animals were born and have grazed solely in the Liver Fluke test Exempt Area described in Part 3 of the accompanying form LB1, and

☐ have had access only to feed from that area, or

☐ are accompanied by an Import Permit number: _____ (Note: Written application required for Import Permit must accompany animals).

Note: If, at the border checkpoint, the equines do not appear to be groomed, or there is fodder or bedding in the transport vehicle, or the transport vehicle, or the transport vehicle is not the same as that in which they departed, the animals will be quarantined and the driver of the vehicle directed to the closest inspection point for inspection of the equines and washdown of the transport vehicle.

The equines described above are not required to be further inspected and the vehicle with registration number above is not required to be washed down.
