

What can pigs eat?



Feeding pigs the wrong food is illegal and can introduce deadly diseases like African swine fever and foot-and-mouth disease to our livestock.

Do not feed pigs

- ✗ Meat or food containing meat
- ✗ Food or food scraps that have been in contact with meat
- ✗ Offal, blood, bones, carcasses
- ✗ Used cooking oil (unless it meets conditions to the right)

Safe to feed pigs

- ✓ Commercial pig feed
- ✓ Grains, fruits, and vegetables that have not been in contact with meat
- ✓ Australian dairy products
- ✓ Meat meals and tallow that meet Australian Standards 5008:2007
- ✓ Australian used cooking oil that is treated to the approved standard for animal feed
