Measures include the number of baits and traps laid, animals culled and a reduction in stock losses.

Bait Rack days were held in Spring 2024 and at the seven (7) stations (pastoral leases) where the bait racks are located. At these bait rack days landholders processed 9.7 tonne of bait meat, producing "1080 baits" for use on landholders' properties for the purpose of wild dog control across the MRBA region. This was considerably less than the planned 12 tonne as would normally occur in Spring. Due to a statewide shortage of meat suitable for bait preparation, we were only able to access 9.7 tonne.

Since July 1st, 2024 our 7 LPMTs have recorded a total of 67 wild dogs trapped or shot and more than 3,000 baits laid. In addition our LPMTs have recorded 11 Feral Cats. Whilst these are not targeted and thus are purely "bycatch" it shows the numbers of Feral Cats are particularly high across the MRBA region. Feral Cats are not a threat to livestock, they do pose considerable threat to native fauna.

Individual efforts are also made on properties, but these figures are mostly not reported. One property in the northern area of MRBA where we do not have contract LPMTs, does report its annual vermin control efforts and recorded 14 wild dogs for the year.

In the northern area of the MRBA region where the country is inaccessible for trapping and shooting, wild dog control is done by aerial baiting. This took place in late September 2024.

A Large Feral Herbivore (LFH) aerial cull operation was carried out by DPIRD from November 2nd - 8th 2024 which destroyed a total of 3,035 LFH. This consisted of 2,698 donkeys, 35 camels and 302 horses.
		LPMTs and landholders are also encouraged to destroy LFH whenever possible. In the first six months of this reporting period, our LPMTs have destroyed 20 donkeys.
