Biosecurity and Agriculture Management Act 2007

Biosecurity and Agriculture Management (Stable Fly) Management Plan 2019

For the purposes of clause 8(4)(b) of the Biosecurity and Agriculture Management (Stable Fly) Management Plan 2019, I approve the following measure for the control of stable fly:

Within 3 days after a crop of fruit or vegetables has been harvested, any part of the crop that remains in or on the soil must be:

- (a) broken up into pieces with a high-speed mulcher, flail mower or slasher (but not incorporated into the soil) and
 - (i) be treated with an approved pesticide; and
 - (ii) left undisturbed and unirrigated (except to the extent necessary to prevent wind erosion) for at least 7 days; and
 - (iii) after it has been left in accordance with paragraph (ii), be thoroughly incorporated into the soil with a rotary hoe or a similar device; or
- (b) completely covered by more than 30cm of compacted soil by the means of appropriate machinery.
