- 2020: Minimum temperature (°C) 1 Aug 2020 - 31 Oct 2020. Produced using Patched Point and DPRO station data. States used in analysis: Western Australia.
- 2021: Minimum temperature (°C) 1 Aug 2021 - 31 Oct 2021. Produced using Patched Point and DPRO station data. States used in analysis: Western Australia.
- 2022: Minimum temperature (°C) 1 Aug 2022 - 31 Oct 2022. Produced using Patched Point and DPRO station data. States used in analysis: Western Australia.
- 2023: Minimum temperature (°C) 1 Aug 2023 - 31 Oct 2023. Produced using Patched Point and DPRO station data. States used in analysis: Western Australia.
